Nancy grew up in the horse business with her mother Helen McClure in Collegeville. Nancy received her first pony at the age of one, and started showing when she was six or seven. She showed ponies, hunters, jumpers, and equitation all through her Junior Years, with multiple wins at Devon, Harrisburg, Madison Square Garden and Washington.

During that time, Nancy also belonged to the Radnor Hunt Pony Club where she competed as a team member in Pony Club Rallies. This is an important experience to us because we follow the US Pony Club Manual of Horsemanship in the care we give the horses. It is also the foundation of our lesson program and summer camp.

As a Junior, Nancy rode for many notables in the horse world ie: The Duponts, Syl Quigley, Raymond Burr, Junie Kulp, and Jack Trainer. At the age of 12 she won at Harrisburg in the Junior Jumpers. She qualified for the Medal and Maclay in 1965, 1966, and 1967.

After her Junior years, Nancy became a professional. She was a consistent winner in the Hunters and Jumpers at all the major indoors, plus Ocala, Palm Beach, and Arizona. She has had multiple Grand Prix wins and placings.

She has been a successful trainer in the Hunters, Ponies, and Jumpers with Juniors and Adults winning many year end awards.

Nancy is also an experienced foxhunter, having hunted with Radnor, Kimberton, Andrews Bridge, and Huntingdon Valley.

Since Nancy no longer rides professionally, Terry Stephens will continue in that capacity here. Nancy brings a lot to the table. She managed Shannondel for years. Her level of experience and knowledge are extensive.
